

20th SERVIER RESEARCH AWARD 2018



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Servier (Suisse) S.A. is honouring outstanding scientific work by young researchers in the field of endocrinology and diabetology. **The award consist in a certificate and a cash prize of CHF 10'000.**

Nominations are now being accepted, with a **deadline for submissions on August 31st 2018.**

The candidates must be researchers working in Switzerland who have contributed, through their clinical or experimental research, to the advancement of knowledge in the field of endocrinology and diabetology. Only works published or accepted for publication during the last two years, and which have not been previously considered for other awards, shall be taken into consideration. The candidates must be **aged 40 or under** and are limited to a single publication per year. In case of multiple authorship of the nominated work, the candidate must be the **primary research contributor.**

The candidates may be reconsidered the following year with the approval of the jury members and insofar as they do not fulfil other exclusion criteria.

ENDOWMENT

The endowment shall be paid to the institution for which the nominated researcher carried out his/her research. The sum may be shared, if applicable, between a clinical work and an experimental work. In this case, the endowment consist of CHF 5'000 for each work.

AWARD

Winners will be announced at the conclusion of the Annual meeting of the Swiss Society of Endocrinology and Diabetology (SGED/SSED) by the chairman of the scientific committee (jury) as well as by a representative of SERVIER (SUISSE) S.A. The board invites the winner to present his/her research as a short talk at the Annual meeting.

APPLICATION

The application must contain the scientific publication and be accompanied by the curriculum vitae, as well as a disclaimer of non-submission to another competition by August 31st, 2018 with the wording "Servier research award 2018".

JURY

The jury comprises 7 members, of which 6 are scientific representatives, including one representative of SERVIER (SUISSE) S.A. The scientific representatives are selected by SERVIER (SUISSE) S.A, and in so far as possible they will be chosen from the following 6 regions (taking into account the languages per region): Basel, Berne, Zurich, Lausanne, Geneva and Ticino. The jury shall appoint the chair annually.

SELECTION

The jury will evaluate the works submitted. Candidates will be nominated on the average of the personal assessment of each jury member. Abstention from allocating points is possible. In all cases, an absolute majority must confirm the nominations of candidates during a second round of votes of the jury members.

LIMITATIONS

The works presented must not go against the commercial interests of SERVIER (SUISSE) S.A. If the selected work goes against these interests, the jury must nominate another winner.

CORRESPONDENCE – LEGAL RECOURSE

There will be no correspondence between the jury and the candidates. Judicial recourse is excluded.

AMENDMENT – TERMINATION

SERVIER (SUISSE) S.A. may at any time decide to modify or terminate this ruling.
